

# Chili the Parrot Bookmark

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Skill Level:



# Materials

- Yarn/wool: I have used Catania yarn from Schachenmayr in red (0115 < 50g), yellow (0208 < 50g), white (0106 < 50g), light brown (0188 < 50g) and dark red (0192 < 50g).
- Crochet hook: 3.0 mm
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Filling
- Two 10 mm black safety eyes
- 20 cm long, 3 cm wide black elastic band

# Abbreviations

St(s)	-	stitch(es)
Ch	-	chain
Sc	-	single crochet
Slst	-	slip stitch
Inc	-	increase (2 sc in next st)
Dec	-	decrease (2 sc worked off together)
(nr)	-	indicates the total number of stitches in the current row/round
FO	-	fasten off

# Important Notes

- All rounds are worked in a continuous spiral (except Chili's hair and tongue). Do not join or turn, unless instructed otherwise
- You may find it useful to use a stitchmarker for counting your rounds
- Take your time to create your amigurumi's face, it is a very important part of the final result
- While stuffing take care to give each part a nice shape

# Size of finished figure

Chili the Parrot bookmark is approximately 36 cm long.

# Realization

## Head



With red:

Round 1.	ch 6	(6)
Round 2.	sc in second ch from hook, 3 sc (= sc in each of the next 3 ch), 3 sc in last ch. Continue on the other side of beginning ch: 3 sc (= sc in each of the next 3 ch), 2 sc into the last ch (you made the first sc into this ch)	(12)
Round 3.	inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, 2 inc	(18)
Round 4.	(sc, inc), 3 sc, (sc, inc) 3-times, 3 sc, (sc, inc) 2-times	(24)
Round 5.	(2 sc, inc), 3 sc, (2 sc, inc) 3-times, 3 sc, (2 sc, inc) 2-times	(30)
Round 6.	(3 sc, inc), 18 sc, (3 sc, inc) 2-times	(33)
Round 7.	(4 sc, inc), 18 sc, (4 sc, inc) 2-times	(36)
Round 8.	(5 sc, inc), 18 sc, (5 sc, inc) 2-times	(39)
Round 9.	(6 sc, inc), 18 sc, (6 sc, inc) 2-times	(42)
Round 10.	– Round 17. sc*	(42)
Round 18.	7 sc, (6 sc, dec) 3-times, 11 sc	(39)
Round 19.	(2 sc, dec), 3 sc, (5 sc, dec) 3-times, 3 sc, (2 sc, dec) 2-times	(33)
Round 20.	6 sc, (4 sc, dec) 3-times, 9 sc	(30)
Round 21.	(sc, dec), 3 sc, (3 sc, dec) 3-times, 3 sc, (sc, dec) 2-times	(24)
Round 22.	4 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec. 6 sc	(22)
Round 23.	sc*	(22)

Slst in next stitch. FO.

## Eyes



Eyeballs with white (make 2):

Round 1.	6 sc in double adjustable ring	(6)
Round 2.	inc*	(12)
Round 3.	(sc, inc)*	(18)
Round 4.	(2 sc, inc)*	(24)

With dark red:

Round 5.	in back loops: (3 sc, inc)*	(30)
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FO; Leave a long yarn tail for sewing it to the head.

Iris with light brown (make 2):

Round 1.	9 sc in double adjustable ring	(9)
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slst in next stitch, FO; leave a long yarn tail for sewing it to the eyeball.

Place the safety eye into the iris, eyeball and finally head. See exact place and position on the pictures below. Secure the safety eye from inside the head.



With invisible stitches sew the iris to each eyeball and sew the eyes to the head.



Stuff the head, insert the elastic band into the opening. Close the opening with invisible stitches (use the loops of the last round) and sew in the elastic band together with it (as you see on the pictures below).



## Beak



With yellow yarn:

Round 1.	4 sc in double adjustable ring	(4)	
Round 2.	sc*	(4)	
Round 3.	inc*	(8)	
Round 4.	– Round 5.	sc*	(8)
Round 6.	(sc, inc)*	(12)	
Round 7.	sc*	(12)	
Round 8.	(2 sc, inc)*	(16)	
Round 9.	(3 sc, inc)*	(20)	
Round 10.	(4 sc, inc)*	(24)	
Round 11.	(3 sc, inc)*	(30)	
Round 12.	(4 sc, inc)*	(36)	
Round 13.	(5 sc, inc)*	(42)	
Round 14.	(6 sc, inc)*	(48)	
Round 15.	–Round 17.	sc*	(48)

FO; leave a long yarn tail, fold it to half and with invisible stitches sew it to the head. For exact place and position see pictures below.



## Lower beak



With yellow yarn:

Round 1.	4 sc in double adjustable ring	(4)
Round 2.	inc*	(8)
Round 3.	(sc, inc)*	(12)
Round 4.	(sc, inc)*	(18)
Round 5.	(2 sc, inc)*	(24)
Round 6.	– Round 8. sc*	(24)

FO; cut the yarn, fold it to half and with invisible stitches sew it to the head. For exact place and position see pictures below.



## Hair



With red yarn:

Row 1.	9 ch	(9)
Row 2.	Turn, start from the 2nd stitch: 8 sc	(8)
Row 3.	11 ch	(11)
Row 4.	10 sc	(10)
Row 5.	6 ch	(6)
Row 6.	5 sc	(5)

FO. Leave a long yarn tail and with invisible stitches sew it to the head. See pictures below.



## Tongue



With dark red yarn:

Row 1.	ch 15	(15)
Row 2.	sc in second ch from hook, 9 slst, 3 sc 3 sc in last ch. Continue on the other side of beginning ch: 3 sc, 10 slst	(29)

FO. Leave a long yarn tail and with invisible stitches sew it into mouth (see pictures above).

## Yellow Tail End



With yellow yarn:

- Round 1. ch 10 (10)  
Round 2. sc in second ch from hook, 7 sc (=sc in each of the next 7 ch), 3 sc in last ch. Continue on the other side of beginning ch: 7 sc (=sc in each of the next 7 ch), 2 sc into the last ch (you made the first sc into this ch) (20)  
Round 3. – Round 6. sc\* (20)

FO. Leave a long yarn tail and with invisible stitches sew it to the other end of the elastic band (see pictures above).

## Talons



Talons are crocheted with yellow yarn:

Shorter talon:

- |          |                                |     |
|----------|--------------------------------|-----|
| Round 1. | 3 sc in double adjustable ring | (3) |
| Round 2. | inc*                           | (6) |
| Round 3. | – Round 6. sc*                 | (6) |

FO.

Longer talon:

- |          |                                |     |
|----------|--------------------------------|-----|
| Round 1. | 3 sc in double adjustable ring | (3) |
| Round 2. | inc*                           | (6) |
| Round 3. | – Round 8. sc*                 | (6) |



In next round the two talons will be crocheted together. Thus, please keep the shorter talon you made before at hand. See pictures above.

- |           |   |      |
|-----------|---|------|
| Round 9.  | sc (insert hook through both talons' stitches, as you see on the first picture above), 5 sc | (6)  |
| Round 10. | 10 sc around the 2 talons   | (10) |
| Round 11. | – Round 15. sc*   | (10) |

Stuff it.

- |           |                      |     |
|-----------|----------------------|-----|
| Round 16. | sc, 2 dec, sc, 2 dec | (6) |
| Round 17. | – Round 21. sc*      | (6) |

FO; close the hole by leading the thread through the 6 stitches of last round, pull it tight and hide the yarn tail in the talon. With invisible stitches sew the talon to the tail end.
